LOS ANGELES – February 28, 2024 – Hillsides, a nonprofit focused on children and youth behavioral health services and foster care and adoption, raised \$560,000 Saturday night at its annual fundraising gala at The Westin Bonaventure Hotel & Suites in Los Angeles. This year's event, *Artist in Residence – The Gallery,* was attended by 335 guests who donated both inperson and online to support Hillsides' work and provide a canvas of hope to help children on their journey toward healing.

Under the vision of gala chair, Ava Herrera, the event space was transformed into a gallery and an exquisite evening unfolded in celebration of art's transcendent power! Guests enjoyed a dynamic performance by artist Amy Burkman and live music from Nancy Wilson of Heart, John Mahon and Davey Johnstone of the Elton John band, Suzanne Falletti formerly of the Metropolitan Opera, Todd Honeycutt, and Kiev Morales.

The evening was dedicated to former Hillsides leader and advocate, John Hitchcock. A special guest, Clifford Sisneros, spoke about his time as a client at Hillsides and how John and others impacted his life well into adulthood and becoming the artisan and entrepreneur he is today.

Fritz Coleman, a longtime friend and supporter of the organization, announced the creation of the new John Hitchcock Fund which will fund the beautification of Hillsides' main campus where hundreds of children like Clifford now call home.
